

2022 Creative Arts Emmy® Awards Event Logistics

Below you will find information regarding your coverage of the **2022 Creative Arts Emmy**[®] **Awards.** The awards will be presented over two consecutive days, **Saturday, Sept. 3 and 4,** at 5:00 p.m. at the Microsoft Theater.

We strongly urge you to read this memo in its entirety, so you have a clear understanding of the event.

LOCATION:

The Media Center for both shows will be located on the **3rd floor of the Microsoft Theater Mezzanine Lobby.**

EVENT TIMELINE:

Saturday 9/3 & 9/4

*Please note there will not be a red carpet for either show.

Please allow ample time for parking, Covid protocols and check-in.

COVID PROTOCOLS:

Based on current COVID-19 safety protocols established by our production company, all 2022 Creative Arts Emmy attendees are required to show proof of a negative COVID test upon arrival at the Microsoft Theater for admittance. The following types of tests will be accepted:

- Lab-based PCR rapid or diagnostic tests
- LAMP or NAAT molecular tests, including Cue Health or Lucira

Antigen tests will not be accepted.

All COVID-19 tests must be collected by the lab/provider within the specified timeframes:

- For the Saturday, Sept. 3, Creative Arts ceremony: test on or after Thursday, Sept. 1
- For the Sunday, Sept. 4, Creative Arts ceremony: test on or after Friday, Sept. 2
- If you are covering both shows, you will test once on or after Thursday, Sept 1.

All test results must be <u>dated</u> and <u>presentable on a mobile device</u>.

Please note that a PCR test may return a positive result up to 90 days after a person first tests positive for COVID. If you are concerned you may not be able to show proof of a negative test, please reach out to emmystesting@televisionacademy.com.

PARKING:

**YOU MUST PRINT THE ATTACHED PARKING SLIP AND BRING IT WITH YOU ON SHOW DAY FOR ACCESS TO EVENT SITE.

Follow the directions on the map to get to Lot C. Show the attached pass to the attendant for admission to the lot. The pass is valid all day, no overnight parking.

Once you have parked, proceed to the Health & Safety Office (HSO) and Credentials Office. Both are located on **G1** in the West Garage at LA Live.

The Television Academy is committed to providing an accessible experience for all attendees. If you require special assistance upon arrival, please let us know at **eventassist@televisionacademy.com**.

ONSITE COVID INSTUCTIONS:

The Health & Safety Office (HSO) and the Credentials Office are located on **G1** in the West Garage at LA Live.

Your first stop will be the HSO. PLEASE HAVE YOUR ID (Driver's License or Passport) OUT AND BE PREPARED TO SHOW IT MULTIPLE TIMES.

At the HSO you will present your negative Covid-19 test for verification, complete the Daily Health Questions, and receive a DAILY HSO WRISTBAND. (NOTE: You will need to do this EVERY DAY you are working on-site.)

CREDENTIAL PICK-UP

Once you have your Daily HSO Wristband, follow the signs to the Credentials Office line where you will be photographed and receive your badge. **Every individual must pick up their own Credential**. There will be no exceptions.

To access the Emmys venues, you must present security at the entrance with BOTH your Daily HSO Wristband AND a Creative Arts Emmys Credential.

MEDIA CENTER:

The Media Center, including the General Press Room and Photo will be open at 2:30 p.m. on Saturday 9/3 and Sunday 9/4.

From the West Garage, proceed along the north side of the Microsoft Theater (adjacent to the JW Marriott hotel) and enter the lobby through **Door 9**. Then take the elevator or escalator to the 3rd floor.

There will be a mult-box for press room video/audio feed and headsets available to watch a stream of the show.

Photo Room Photographers: We will be lighting the stage for cameras in the General Photo Room. **Only camera-mounted flashes will be allowed.**

Please note that we are using Arri LED Sky Panels with a color temp of approximately 5600k.

WI-FI:

Basic Wi-Fi will be provided in the Press Center, and a password will be posted.

*If you ordered internet access or hard phone lines, you will be billed separately and directly by Crypto Arena Telecom. Your lines will be marked with your position.

Clips and interviews may be used only in the segment of your program covering the Creative Arts Emmys and for no other purpose whatsoever. Clips from the Creative Arts Award show are cleared for use from the date of the broadcast for seven (7) days; additionally, clips may be used in weekend-type news shows during the weekend following the initial broadcast. For any use after that date, permission must be obtained from the Television Academy. The aggregate length of all clips used will not exceed two (2) minutes. Violation of these provisions will be grounds for revoking your credential.

BROADCAST PARTNER:

An edited presentation of the Creative Arts Emmys will be broadcast on **Saturday**, **Sept. 10 (8:00 PM ET/PT)** on FXX and streamed on Hulu. Both shows will be produced by Bob Bain Productions.
