Viewfinder: Viacom Emerging Directors Program

SUBMISSION PERIOD: November 2nd – December 14th

The ViacomCBS ViewFinder Emerging Directors Program is a company-wide initiative which seeks to provide directors with underrepresented voices an opportunity to enhance their skillset and grow their network. Selected applicants participate in a two-year curriculum focused on honing their craft and professional development. Participants will have the opportunity to meet with network and creative executives with an eye towards shadowing established TV directors on scripted and non-scripted programming across ViacomCBS's Domestic Media Networks. In addition to craft development and networking opportunities, ViewFinder participants will each be provided with monetary support by ViacomCBS to assist the participant in producing a project to further develop their portfolios.
